Addaset surfacing gets top marks for student accommodation

Addaset Resin Bound Porous surfacing was selected for a new student accommodation complex at an independent school in Shropshire.

Wrekin House is part of Concord College near Shrewsbury, an independent school for 370 day and boarding pupils with more than 50 members of staff. The 40-bedroom complex is on an 80-acre campus in a rural setting.



Addagrip approved contractor, Booher Construction, was appointed by main contractor Pave Aways to install a resin bound porous paving system around Wrekin House. The contractor chose Addaset in a 6mm Maple Gold to complement the building and the surrounding beautiful countryside.

The durable and low maintenance surface was ready for the students' occupation in September 2014.
