Cibes engineers get pupils on the move again

A primary school in Plymouth was able to rapidly restore accessibility for its pupils after being advised to get in touch with Cibes.

Marine Academy's previous lift had failed and attempts to get it fixed had led to frustration until a parent of a pupil, who worked for Cibes, recommended an assessment.

Alex Bettinson, Site Manager at Marine Academy Plymouth, said: "The previous primary school lift was a unique platform lift that had failed, which resulted in a variety of lift companies assessing the situation but did not understand what was needed and made it worse.

The lift can hold a weight of 400kg and is installed with fire doors that comply with safety requirements for most public and commercial buildings.
