The Matador Stands its Ground Again

Heald's latest innovation security product the Matador has now had its fixed bollard tested; the same impact test was undertaken on one of the single fixed bollards.

The test consisted of one of the Matadors end bollards being crash tested at a 45 degree angle. This surface mounted fixed bollard successfully arrested the vehicle with zero penetration and zero dispersion.



The Matador fixed comprises three or four fixed bollards mounted onto a specially designed plate; it is truly surface mounted and requires simply bolting to a suitable concrete base. It therefore has the unique advantage of being installed on a permanent or temporary basis.

It is bolted into place by specialist fixings available from Heald. It also has the option of being fitted into ground with only 125mm excavation.

It is another revolutionary new product which requires no additional ties or anchor points, it simply sits beside an entrance barrier and secures the perimeter.

It can be fitted in conjunction with other Heald products such as Matador moving automatic bollards or [Raptors](#), [Shallow mount Viper blockers](#) or any of the company's [other products](#).

This now means that any of Heald's automatic HVM barriers can be fitted with added advantage of a complete perimeter solution.
