The three-day workshop and social networking event will offer an insight into delivering low-carbon, eco-friendly master finishes that transform buildings inside and out. The course will also leave a positive and lasting impression on the local community through a painting project which will see trainees and professionals partner up on an assignment to transform a school in the suburbs of Amsterdam.
