Innovative Glass Designs from Kevala Stairs

Kevala Stairs' new partner Siller Treppen, a specialist staircase designer and manufacturer from Italy, has many interesting and innovative stairs in glass, timber and stone.



The Siller ranges are Mistral and Europa. The Mistral Glass and Timber Stair (above) is a self supporting staircase design that can be constructed with a glass balustrade and treads in glass, wood, or stone. By using a particular toughened and laminated glass for the balustrade, Kevala Stairs can achieve a tread thickness of just 50 mm to 60 mm.



From the Europa range is a fully cantilevered self supporting helical staircase tread system (left). The treads are made from a cone shaped structural steel form that has been overlaid with walnut. In the picture these have been attached to a load-bearing reinforced concrete wall; other methods of attaching the structural treads are available. The inside balustrade is a non-load bearing glass form. It does not need to be attached to the treads therefore giving a fully floating appearance.
