The Sash Window Workshop chosen to aid transformation of former warehouse

The owner of a former late Victorian warehouse that was being transformed into a welcoming family home chose The Sash Window Workshop to carry out works to the windows and doors.

The property had fallen into disrepair and required major renovation. Rotten windows and doors all required replacement. The replacement windows and doors needed to be double glazed and to comply with the conservation area requirements.
