## **Titon offers Ventilation Contractor Training**

It is structured to meet the requirements of the Approved Document Part F (Ventilation) of the Building Regulations 2010 and is recognised as a demonstration of competence for Competent Person Schemes (CPS).

The course and handbook covers installation, inspection commissioning and handover of the four common ventilation systems defined in Part F, which includes intermittent fans, passive stacks, mechanical ventilation and mechanical ventilation with heat recovery systems. It will also provide an understanding of all the legal issues surrounding the installation of these systems and guidance on completion and submission of all the appropriate notifications.
